Japan Market was closed on 20th September 2021, Monday on account of Old Age Day holiday.

The top gainers and top losers mentioned below are of 17th September, 2021.

Brokers have said that investors are now buying on hopes for a possible fresh stimulus to be compiled by Suga's successor, who many believe will have a higher approval rate.

The estimated number of people aged 65 or older in Japan stood at a record high of 36.4 million as of Wednesday, an increase of 220,000 from a year before, the internal affairs ministry said Sunday.

Malaysia welcomes China's bid to join CPTPP (Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership).

Japan's government downgraded its economic assessment amid rising downside risks from the current domestic and overseas infections and negative effects through the supply chains.

Japan's economy expanded at an annual rate of 1.9% in the April-June quarter, faster than initially estimated, as a brisk global recovery spurred factory output and prompted firms to invest more in equipment and other capital.
